Caribbean Journalist Workshop: Challenges for the Environment and the Ozone Layer

The United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP) is pleased to announce the training seminar “Caribbean Journalist Workshop: Challenges for the Environment and the Ozone Layer”, to be held in Nassau, Commonwealth of The Bahamas, from 15 to 16 October 2012.

The aim of the workshop is to strengthen skills on environmental journalism, providing media professionals with relevant information, tools and inputs for transmitting messages related to environment protection and governance in the countries of the Caribbean. The workshop will focus on the Montreal Protocol for the Protection of the Ozone Layer, as well as on the main messages of the fifth Global Environment Outlook report (GEO-5), which examines the state and trends of the environment.

This call is directed to editors and journalists of print and electronic media as well as news agencies in the English-speaking countries of the Caribbean.

Each participant shall publish at least one news story on one of the topics addressed during the workshop within two weeks of the conclusion of the face to face session, in order to officially complete his/her participation in the workshop.

UNEP will select a limited number of journalists to participate in the workshop and will cover their travel expenses (airplane ticket, lodging and meals) according to the UN rules.

Participants are responsible for obtaining a visa for The Bahamas, as applicable. They are also responsible for obtaining a visa for the United States, if their itinerary includes a stopover in that country.
